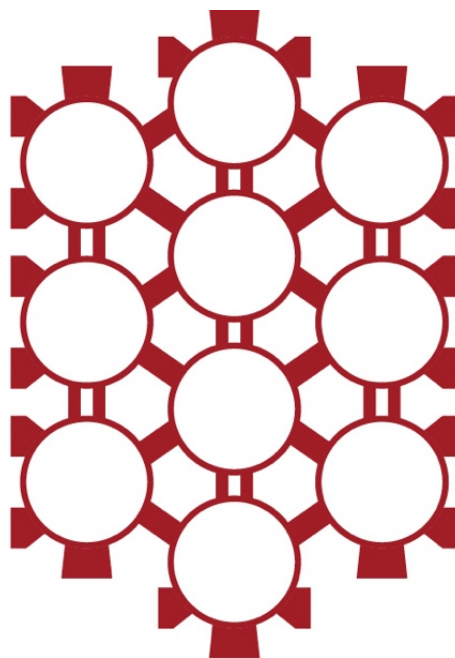

Reflection from Revd. Bruce:
