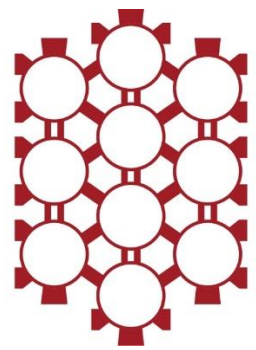

Changes – we will be changing the Eucharistic music for our Choral Eucharist in the near future and move the St. Mary's Mass to the Sung Eucharist. There will be a practice with the congregation beforehand.

Choir's service – The choir will be singing on 21 – 23 February at Chesterfield Parish Church with ECS. We hope that the Choir's service will bring joy and glory.

Choral Evensong – in March we have a fifth Sunday which allows us to have a traditional Choral Evensong at the usual time of 14.30. On **Sunday 30th March** join us for this sung service with canticles, prayers and responses, an anthem and sung psalm; *'for music is to the soul what food is to the body'*.
